Rotations include:

- Children's Medical Center Dallas (CMC)
- Clements University Hospital
- Multiple local community hospitals in Dallas and Fort Worth

Pediatric experience:

- PGY-1: 4 week and 2 week blocks at CMC
- PGY-2 & 3: longitudinal shifts (1-2 per mo.)

Electives:

- Electives available in all available fellowships including EMS, toxicology, ultrasound, administration, global health & disaster medicine, advanced airway, regional anesthesia, and several ICUs
- 2 month elective in a community hospital in New Zealand for a select number of residents in their third year

Ultrasound experience:

- PGY-1: 1 month rotation and longitudinal curriculum
